RESOLUTION NO. 2015-2

A resolution of the Board of Commissioners of the Anderson Island Park & Recreation District expressing support for provisions in the 2015 Shoreline Management plan adopted by the Pierce County Council restricting the disposal of toxic dredging spoils and establishing limitations on aquaculture practices within the Nisqually Reach Aquatic Reserve.

WHEREAS, the mission of the Anderson Island Park & Recreation District is to preserve open space, wildlife habitat and natural greenbelt, to provide recreational opportunities for island residents and visitors, and to preserve and maintain facilities for the benefit of the public; and

WHEREAS, the Nisqually Reach Aquatic Reserve has been established to protect marine life and habitat in the waters surrounding Anderson Island; and

WHEREAS, the Pierce County Council has adopted amendments to its Shoreline Management Plan restricting the disposal of toxic dredging spoils and establishing limitations on aquaculture practices within the Nisqually Reach Aquatic Reserve,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE ANDERSON ISLAND PARK & RECREATION DISTRICT, AS FOLLOWS,
